How to Nominate

1. Nominees and their activities must be based in Maine.
2. Complete the Nomination Form with your name and information *and* nominee's name and information.
3. On a second page, please print or type:
 - How have you come to know the nominee?
 - Reason for nomination
 - Describe nominee's accomplishments citing specific examples
 - Include nominee's accomplishments that are innovative or unique that truly reflect "going the extra mile"
 - Describe how nominee has increased awareness or implemented a project or program, whether at work or as a volunteer
4. You may also include, but not required:
 - Letters of support for the nominee
 - Nominee's resume
 - Supporting materials, ie, newspaper articles, brochures
5. Please keep a photocopy of your materials as submissions and attachments will not be returned.

Deadline

The deadline to receive nominations is Wednesday, June 30, 2010. Nominations received after this date will not be considered. Please send your nominations to:

Cure Cancer for ME Award Categories

1. Outreach and Education Award

An individual or organization that demonstrates leadership in programming awareness of breast health, through the press, in Maine, is eligible. This includes:

- Media outlets (TV, radio stations, print outlets)
- Organizations (community-based, non-profits, healthy coalitions)
- Advertising, marketing, public relations firms

2. Medical Care and Research Award

A health care professional or organization in the health care industry that has gone above and beyond to make a positive contribution to, or difference in, the treatment of breast cancer.

3. Grassroots Advocate Award

An individual person, group or an employer that has provided leadership at a grassroots level and increased awareness of the importance of breast health with their sphere of influence or the community at large by:

- Conducting an outreach program for employees
- Providing materials to increase awareness
- Providing incentives to encourage self-care

4. The Meredith Burgess Spirit of Life Award

An individual who demonstrates unfailing optimism and advocacy when dealing with breast cancer. A person who exhibits/embodies the spirit of “living with cancer” and who works to carry a positive message to others.

5. Lifetime Inspiration Award

An individual with an exceptional history of support, advocacy and caring for the issue of breast cancer. A person who's length of service is only matched to their determination to make a difference in the lives of others. Those eligible include:

- Breast cancer survivors (those in remission or currently battling cancer)
